## **SCOTT BRIGHT LAUNCHES CAMPAIGN FOR COLORADO'S 13<sup>TH</sup> SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

*Conservative Businessman, Early Childhood Education Provider, Community Leader  
Poised to Flip Democrat-Held Seat*

(PLATTEVILLE, CO) – Conservative businessman Scott Bright today launched his campaign for State Senate District 13, currently represented by term-limited Democrat Kevin Priola. Bright, a 53-year resident of the district, is a third-generation owner of ABC Child Development Centers, which runs 25 licensed early childhood centers, has 250 employees in Weld County, and serves over 2,000 families.

“The American Dream is under assault by Colorado Democrats’ agenda of higher taxes, job-killing regulations, hostility toward education innovation, and criminal-coddling policies,” said Bright. “With conservative leadership and ideas, Colorado’s best days could still lie ahead. I’m running to help launch a conservative renaissance in the state legislature focused on protecting our communities and defending the values of smaller government, low taxes, and better schools.”

“The Colorado Senate desperately needs more conservatives, more legislators who take their jobs seriously, more business and community leaders, and more education reformers. That’s Scott Bright. Scott will be a tremendous asset for the Senate Republicans, and I’m honored to endorse his candidacy,” said Senator Barb Kirkmeyer.

In addition to running ABC Child Development Centers, Scott Bright is a husband, father of two, and highly involved in his community. Scott is former President of the Greeley Downtown Rotary, former Chair and Executive Director of the Colorado Early Education Network, is President of the Colorado Trails Preservation Alliance, and serves as President of the Early Childhood Education Association of Colorado.

SD 13, newly configured after redistricting, consists of eastern Greeley, Evans, Garden City, Platteville, Gilcrest, Fort Lupton, and Brighton. In the 2020 presidential contest, Donald Trump defeated Joe Biden by 3.7 percentage points in the district and in the U.S. Senate contest Cory Gardner defeated John Hickenlooper by 5.7 percentage points, making the district a strong prospect for a Republican take-over.
